

Special Town Council Meeting May 22, 2023, at Town Hall 103 E Hamilton St.

Pledge of allegiance

Public Comment on agenda – Gary Hilliker asked how many applicants, Rahn Abbott advised one.

Review Mayor Applicant and Appoint Position

Rahn Abbott reads letter of interest from Judy Edwards for mayor position. Rahn opens up the discussion. Tom asks when the term for interim mayor would end, would have to. Tammy asks Judy what her main strengths and weaknesses would be as a mayor. Judy Edwards advises a strength of hers is to analyze situations and find solutions to meet those needs. Judy advises one of her weaknesses would be impatience, likes to have plans made and have them implanted and now stew over the same matters. Tammy asks about grant writing. Tonya asks what applicant what she believes her biggest challenges as a town. Judy advises that she is at a disadvantage as she does not know the budget or the finances of the town, but would say the water system, development, community safety, disaster plans.
