

Meeting Minutes: Special Sheridan Town Council Meeting on October 31st, 2022

New Business:

LATC Funding: Mayor Mike presented notice of the LATC Funding (Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Funds) allocated to the county for 2022 and 2023. The deadline for applications is November 1st, 2022, thus Mayor Mike suggested and submitted application relative to the sewer project at the Senior Center due to the project involving locally the Town of Sheridan, Ruby Valley Medical Center, and Madison County (i.e. Tobacco Root Mountains Care Center). Tom Roberts moved to accept and submit application for the LATC Funding to Madison County; Rahn Abbott seconded the motion; two ayes, two yes; motion carried.

Old Business:

MSIT (Main Street Improvement Team) Sign at Main Street Park: Kaye Carter Colwell, representative for MSIT, presented for the second time, a discussion regarding the project. Tom Roberts moved to approve the MSIT sign at the Main Street Park pending details of the sign's anchorage; Rahn Abbott seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried.
